

Willowmere & Chasewater Lakes

Willowmere and Chasewater Lakes are located on farm land at Newney Green near the village of Writtle within 4 miles of Chelmsford in Essex . Willowmere is a three acre lake surrounded by mature trees and fringed with bulrushes. There are boats available but has the option of bank fishing on three sides. This lake is for fly fishing only. Chasewater is a four acre lake with three islands and 'moat' and 'pool' areas shared by game and course fishermen. Being an L shape all of the water in the moat is within fly casting distance. This lake is available for coarse and fly fishing.



DIRECTIONS

The Waters are located on farm land at Newney Green near the village of Writtle within 4 miles of Chelmsford in Essex. They are accessible from the A414 via a locked farm gate or via the farm access road off Victoria Road.

RULES

All Waters

1. No night fishing. Fishermen to have left the water by published lighting up times
2. No rubbish or abandoned tackle to be left on the banks, boats or the farmland.
3. Membership card to be carried when on the water and surrendered on demand for inspection.
4. Respect for the farm property and neighbours to be shown at all times.
5. Care must be taken in handling fish and they must be returned to the water as soon as possible.
6. Respect must be show to other anglers.

Chasewater Pool - Coarse Lake

1. Barbless hooks to be used on all occasions.
2. The use of keepnets is discouraged to avoid unnecessary stress to fish.
3. The use of ground bait is allowed but its use must be kept to a minimum.
4. Fishing for coarse fish is restricted to Chasewater Pool at the Pool side of the dividing net.
5. All trout caught to be returned.
6. Fly or spin allowed for 'Game and Coarse' members.

Willowmere & Chasewater Moat Lakes

1. Fishing to be with fly only.
2. Fish limit – Only 1 fish can be taken on any one day. Any subsequent visits in the same week to be catch and release.
3. Barbless hooks/flies must
